FREQENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What kind of school is Muneer Academy and how does it differ from traditional education?

Muneer is a non-profit private school for boys and girls located in Warren, Michigan. Muneer differs from traditional education in that it offers full-time programs for memorizing the Quran and learning Islamic studies, while upholding high academic standards in secular education.

What programs are offered at Muneer Academy?

Muneer Academy offers three full-time programs for students who are interested in increasing their knowledge in Islamic and secular education. We offer a Quran memorization program where students can memorize the entire Quran and learn the basics of Islamic studies, such as tafseer, seerah, hadith, and fiqh. We also offer an intensive 5-6 year Islamic studies and Arabic program where students will learn Arabic, tafseer, hadith, seerah, fiqh, aqeedah, and more. Muneer also provides certified secular education for grades 4 - 12 in the core subjects of Mathematics, Science, Social Studies, and English Language Arts.

How do I apply to Muneer Academy? What does the admissions board consider when evaluating applications?

The first step in the application process is to complete an online application. The next steps are to submit the required documents and complete an interview. The Admissions Office considers all materials submitted when evaluating a candidate. We also consider grades, location, age, family background, as well as recommendations for each applicant.

Does Muneer Academy charge tuition? What are my payment options?

Yes, Muneer is funded by student tuition and charges 12 monthly payments per student. Monthly tuition payments of \$450 are due on the 1st of each month via automatic withdrawals from a checking account or savings account.



FREQENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is the school schedule for students?

The student's daily schedule consists of classes Monday - Friday from 8:30 AM until 4:30 PM year-round. Academic classes are from 8:30 AM until 12:00 PM and Hifdh and Aalimah classes are from 12:45 – 4:30 PM.

Is there a school uniform policy?

Students are expected to dress in a manner appropriate for a school learning environment. Students are expected to dress in neat and clean clothes that fit well and are in good repair, modest in style, and appropriate for the school and learning environment.

Muneer Boys:

Students are required to wear the topee/Imama (Islamic hat), Shalwar (above the ankles), curta/jubba/jalbab (modest) daily for class. Boys are not permitted to trim their beards.

Muneer Girls:

Students are required to wear modest clothing, such as abayahs/skirts daily for class. No nail polish or makeup will be acceptable for the learning environment.

Who operates the school?

Muneer Academy is operated by a team of qualified board and colleagues with a wide variety of experiences and degrees that oversee daily operations of the school and curriculum.

Is the Aalimah program beginner friendly? What knowledge will my daughter need to know prior to joining?

Yes, the Aalimah program is beginner friendly. The program starts with elementary levels in Arabic and Islamic Studies and builds the student's knowledge every year. Students will not need any prior knowledge before they start the program, however there is a 6th grade level requirement to enter the program.

FREQENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is the school policy regarding phones?

Muneer Academy follows a zero-tolerance policy for any electronic devices. No headphones, music, game devices, electronic devices, cell phones or cameras are allowed at school. Any electronic device confiscated will only be returned to parents.

How diverse is the student body?

The student body consist of students from all across Michigan, varying in cultural backgrounds, languages, and ethnicities.

Do students have holiday breaks?

Yes, students have three main holiday breaks in the Winter, during Ramadan, and for Eid Al-Adha. Holiday breaks will last anywhere from 2 – 6 weeks.

How does Muneer Academy handle bullying and student discipline?

Muneer has a ZERO tolerance policy to student bullying. Any student that is found to be harassing or bullying other students will be under enrollment review. Each case that is brought to the administration's attention will be handled accordingly.

Will my child need to bring lunch to school every day?

Yes, students will need to bring with lunch and snacks to school daily. They may stored in their lockers or backpacks.

What is the Attendance Policy of Muneer Academy?

Consistent attendance is a key predictor that a student will be successful in the completion of our programs. Persistent absences may cause serious academic problems (including but not limited to course failure.) The administration or the class teacher will normally review the matter with parents before being subject to appropriate disciplinary action.
